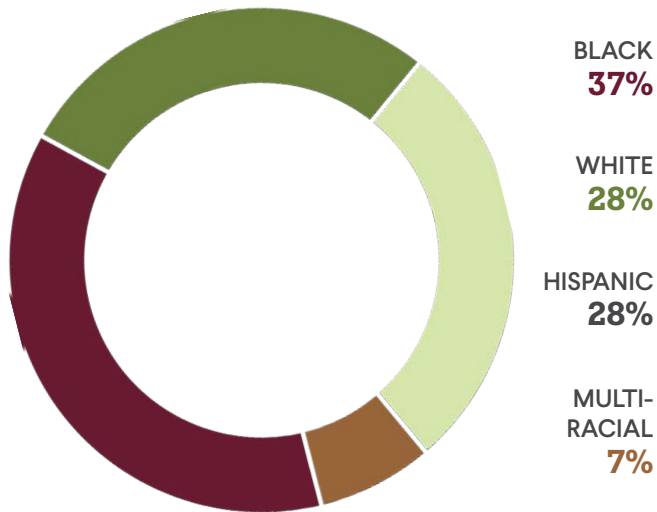

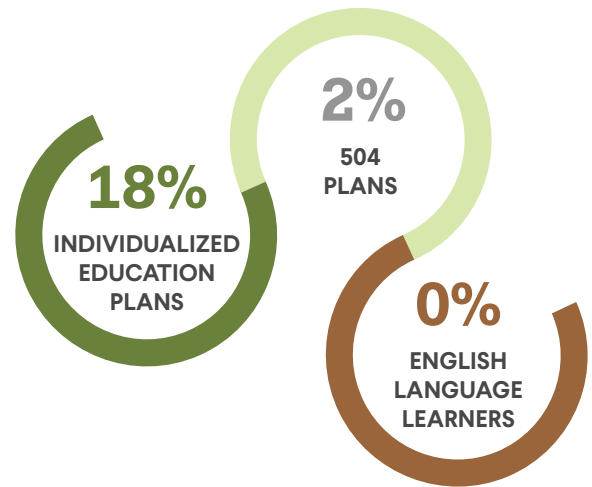

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



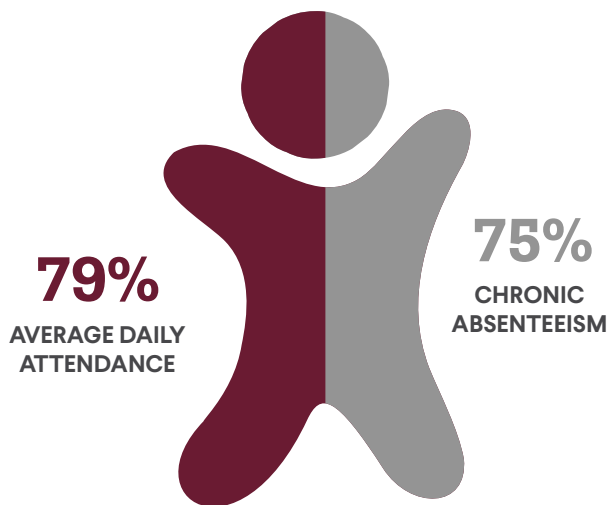

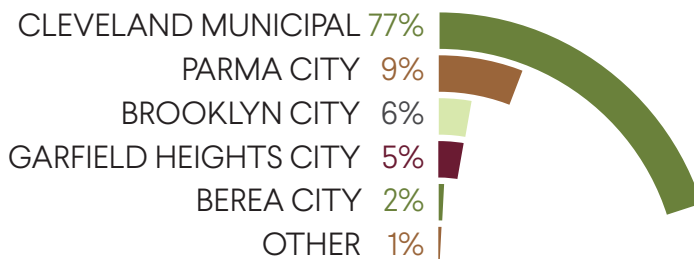

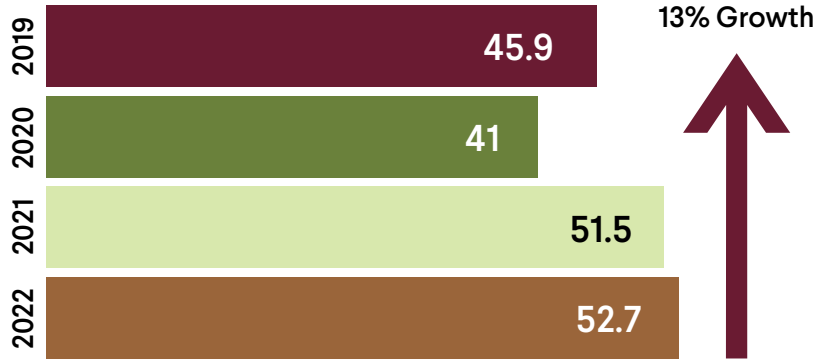

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

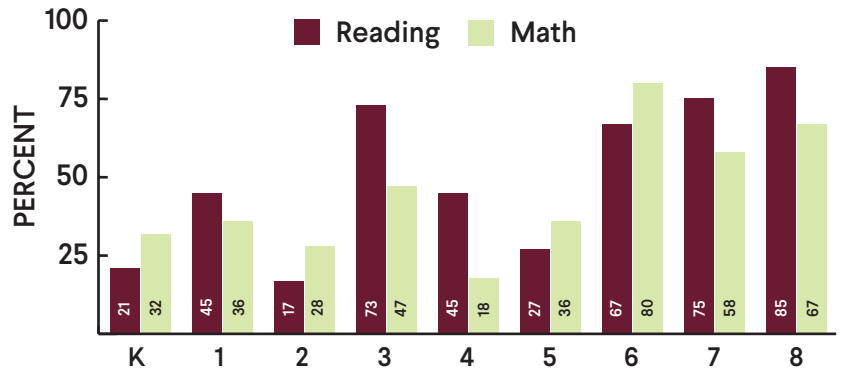
Cleveland Preparatory Academy is among an exceptional group of schools emerging from the pandemic stronger than before. This year, Cleveland Prep increased its Performance Index (PI) Score by 2% to 52.7, a 13% increase to its pre-pandemic score of 45.9. Additionally, all grade levels met the state's student growth expectations in English Language Arts and Math. 100% of students met the Third Grade Reading requirements for promotion to Grade 4.
